

Rodeo Sanitary District

Contractors with a valid Class A – General Engineering license are invited to bid construction of the Comprehensive Wastewater Master Plan Near Term Improvements-WWTP Projects in Rodeo, CA, for the Rodeo Sanitary District. The Project consists of replacement of the digester heating equipment, including spiral heat exchangers, sludge recirculation pumps, new high efficiency condensing boiler for hot water, new air compressor, piping, valves and electrical work. Relocation of digester building equipment to exterior location including concrete slab, metal canopy and associated work. Replacement of stop gates at the headworks and grit chamber. Miscellaneous surface repair of concrete walkways and replacement of corner walkway slabs at the aeration tank. The Engineer's opinion of probable construction cost is \$700,000.

The project will be funded by the California Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF). The project will require compliance relative to utilization of DBE, including the Six Good Faith Efforts (GFE) listed in the appendix prior to bid opening. Contractor shall submit EPA Form 6100-3 DBE Subcontractor Performance Form, EPA Form 6100-4 DBE Subcontractor Utilization Form and any required attachments with the bid.
