A) FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020 CAPITAL BUDGET (DISCUSSION AND ACTION)

The Budget Committee met several times to develop the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 Capital Budget. The requested Fiscal Year 2019 – 2020 Capital Budget of \$4,545,000 will potentially result in a spending deficit of \$2,281,000, due to construction of the Bar Screen Project. This will potentially reduce the total capital reserve from \$3,738,000 to \$1,457,000. The District's Capital Reserve Policy requires a \$2 million reserve, thus resulting in deficit of approximately \$543,000. At the end of the 2018 – 2019 Fiscal Year, the District will have an Operations Reserve of approximately \$2,340,000. By policy, the District is required to have an Operations Reserve of 60% of the current operating budget. Currently that results in a Operations Reserve requirement of \$1,404,000. As a result, the District has \$936,000 in excess Operations Reserve. District staff and the Budget Committee recommend the transfer of \$750,000 from the Operations Reserve to the Capital Budget to accommodate the capital cost of the Bar Screen Project.

MOTION: By Noble, seconded by Frakes to approve the F/Y 2019-2020 Capital Budget. Motion passed by unanimous vote.
