

# MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE RODEO SANITARY DISTRICT LOCATION: JOHN SWETT UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT BOARD ROOM, 400 PARKER AVE., RODEO, CA

Manager Beall and Operations Manager Greer provided written reports; below is a summary of some of the highlights.

a) General Manager's Report:

#### **Near-Term Capital Improvements**

RAS and WAS System Improvements Project

Telstar's subcontractor, Sonnikson, has completed the construction of the polymer storage pad and driveway. Sonnikson will return shortly to complete the asphalt and then, in a few weeks, to construct the polymer tote shade structure, the RAS/WAS Room platform extension, and install process piping. Major submittal review is ongoing (Thickener Control Panel, VFD Panel, RAS/WAS Control Panel, Pump Bypass Panel, Polymer feed

system). Electrical construction is not expected to begin until the end of the year or early in 2026.

### **Studies and Grants**

Senate Bill 1 Sea Level Rise Adaptation Planning Grant Program -

RSD was not selected for funding under the SB 1 Sea Level Rise Adaptation Planning Grant Program. The Ocean Protection Council cited the need for coordination with Contra Costa County's regional shoreline adaptation plan and recommended RSD remain engaged in that process. #### b) Operations Manager Report

Date range September 1st, 2025, through September 30th, 2025.

This month, the Operations team rented a boom lift to complete some elevated work throughout the District's treatment plant site. This work included diagnosing and repairing streetlights, tree trimming, gutter cleaning, and finishing repairs of the centrifuge structure and applying the heavy-duty cover. Remaining trimming was contracted due to time constraints and the availability of the chipping machine. The operations team also spent time preparing for Rodeo's big event in October, which is the Chili Cookoff and Car show. Learning from john Muir earth day and wanting to improve upon the Districts display the team assembled better giveaways for the table, had a custom tablecloth made, blew up poop emoji balloons to better capture attention of attendees and the two biggest changes were the grease in the pipe display and the peoples choice award for best Chili and Salsa in which the attendees would cast their vote at the RSD booth and the votes would be tallied and a winner would be announced. Great improvement and effort well spent by the operations team!

# Sanitary Sewer Overflows (SSO) and Sewer Service Calls (SSC)

There were zero (0) Sanitary Sewer Overflows (SSO)

There was one (1) **Private Lateral Sewer Discharge (PLSD).** This was a toilet burp, which was a result of cleaning and TV work being performed on Third St for RSD. The cause of this Burp is either related to guidance given to this residence by previous District staff on how to cap their lateral system or due to poor lateral upkeep. A third-party cleanup team came in and did the minor cleanup required due to the burp caused. The District will work with the resident on a long-term solution to try and prevent this from reoccurring. There was one (1) **Sanitary Sewer Calls (SSC)** on Napa St. a resident called about a poor draining situation in their basement. The operations team responded and found flow was excellent in the main servicing line. A complementary cleaning was performed on the servicing mainline with no other findings. The reporting resident was advised to call a plumber to address their issue. During the line cleaning, a neighbor complained about hearing the cleaning in their toilet. Two efforts were made to address this neighbor's complaint, with no call back from this neighbor.

#### c) Counsel for the District

District Counsel Diaz provided an update on SB 707, the Brown Act rewrite bill. The bill has gone through amendments and has been signed by the Governor. The final version has minimal impact on RSD, as most provisions apply to larger cities with city councils or special districts that span entire counties or serve sizable populations. No significant changes are required to our current course of action.
