Changing roles and a recent retirement have brought on another employment opportunity here at the District.

The Rodeo Sanitary District is a small 0.50 MGD activated sludge plant with Hypochlorite disinfection located on the edge of San Pablo Bay right between the cities of Crockett and Hercules. The District when fully staffed, is composed of less than 10 people who execute all of the functions needed for day-to-day operations with assistance from outside contractors and vendors. The collections system is also maintained by the District and has a total length of 25 miles, which almost a quarter has been completely replaced within in the last eight years. The collections system conveys the sewage back to the plant almost all via gravity and then uses two lift stations within a mile of the plant to help flow the rest of the way here.

Upcoming projects include Primary and secondary Clarifier repairs and coating, Aeration basin panel rehab and instrumentation replacement, Main Administration building expansion and upgrades, and Collections system pipeline repairs.
